

## State of Illinois School Health Requirements

The Riverton School Board has determined that the **Friday of the third full week of school** will be the due date for which mandated records must be received by the school nurse. Exclusions may happen if the needed forms are not turned in on time.

### Students New to Illinois:

- Must meet the below grade level immunization requirements.
- Must have a physical exam completed in Illinois **within 30 days of enrollment**.
  - Form must be signed by the doctor or person who is licensed to perform the physical.
  - The medical history portion, located at the top of the physical exam, must be completed and signed by the parent or legal guardian.
  - The diabetes risk assessment, lead screening, TB testing and physical education areas must all be filled out completely by the doctor's office.
- Dental examination must be performed by a licensed dentist.
- Eye examination must be performed by a licensed optometrist.

### Students New to Riverton School District (within the State of Illinois transfer):

- Must meet the below grade level requirements.

### Pre K:

- Physical examination must be completed within one calendar year prior to the first day of school.
  - Form must be signed by the doctor or person who is licensed to perform the physical.
  - Medical history portion, located at the top of the physical exam, is for the parents to fill out and sign.
  - Diabetes risk assessment, lead screening, TB testing and physical education areas must all be filled out completely by the doctor's office.
  - Immunization record must be filled out with vaccines up to date. Vaccines needed: **DTP- 4** doses; **Polio- 3** doses; **MMR- 1** dose; **Varicella/Chicken Pox- 1** dose; **Pneumococcal- 4**doses; **Hepatitis B- 3** doses.

### Kindergarten:

- Physical examination must be completed within one calendar year prior to the first day of school.
  - Form must be signed by the doctor or person who is licensed to perform the physical.
  - Medical history portion, located at the top of the physical exam, is for the parents to fill out and sign.
  - Diabetes risk assessment, lead screening, TB testing and physical education areas must all be filled out completely by the doctor's office.
  - Immunization record must be filled out and with vaccines up to date. Vaccines needed: **DTP- 4** or more doses with last booster on or after 4<sup>th</sup> birthday; **Polio- 4** doses with last booster on or after 4<sup>th</sup> birthday; **MMR- 2** doses; **Varicella/Chicken Pox- 2** doses; **Pneumococcal- 4** doses; **Hepatitis B- 3** doses.
- Dental examination must be performed by a licensed dentist.
- Eye examination must be performed by a licensed optometrist.

## 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade:

- Dental examination must be performed by a licensed dentist.

## 6th Grade:

- Physical examination must be completed within one calendar year prior to the first day of school.
  - Form must be signed by the doctor or person who is licensed to perform the physical.
  - Medical history portion, located at the top of the physical exam, is for the parents to fill out and sign.
  - Diabetes risk assessment, lead screening, TB testing and physical education areas must all be filled out completely by the doctor's office.
  - Immunization record must be filled out and with vaccines up to date. Vaccines needed: **DTP**- 4 or more doses with last booster on or after 4<sup>th</sup> birthday; **Polio**- 4 doses with last booster on or after 4<sup>th</sup> birthday; **MMR**- 2 doses; **Varicella/Chicken Pox**- 2 doses; **Pneumococcal**- 4 doses; **Hepatitis B**- 3 doses; **TDAP**- 1 dose; **Meningococcal**- 1 dose.
- Dental examination must be completed by a licensed dentist and proof turned into the school by May 15th of that school year.

## 9th Grade:

- Physical examination must be completed within one calendar year prior to the first day of school.
  - Form must be signed by the doctor or person who is licensed to perform the physical.
  - Medical history portion, located at the top of the physical exam, is for the parents to fill out and sign.
  - Diabetes risk assessment, lead screening, TB testing and physical education areas must all be filled out completely by the doctor's office.
  - Immunization record must be filled out and with vaccines up to date. Vaccines needed: **DTP**- 4 or more doses with last booster on or after 4<sup>th</sup> birthday; **Polio**- 4 doses with last booster on or after 4<sup>th</sup> birthday; **MMR**- 2 doses; **Varicella/Chicken Pox**- 2 doses; **Pneumococcal**- 4 doses; **Hepatitis B**- 3 doses; **TDAP**- 1 dose; **Meningococcal**- 1 dose.
- Dental examination must be completed by a licensed dentist and proof turned into the school by May 15th of that school year.

## 12th Grade:

- Proof of immunization: 2nd MCV (Meningococcal) Vaccine required after 16th birthday and before the start of the school year.
